During a program's 5-year term of accreditation, NAEYC will establish procedures to ensure that its accredited programs maintain substantial compliance with the current early childhood program accreditation standards and criteria.

The award of NAEYC Accreditation is null and void if it is determined that false information was knowingly submitted to NAEYC at any time during the assessment process or in reference to maintaining a program's accreditation status.
