Official Rules for the Child Care Survey Sweepstakes

No Purchase Necessary. A Purchase Will Not Increase Your Chances Of Winning.

- 1. **Eligibility**: The Sweepstakes is open only to legal residents of the United States who are at least eighteen (18) years old. Employees of the National Association for the Education of Young Children ("Sponsor"), as well as their immediate family (spouse, parents, siblings, and children) and household members of those employees, are not eligible to enter.
- 2. **Entry Period:** The Sweepstakes begins at 9:00 am ET on Monday, January 8 and ends at midnight ET on Sunday, January 21st (the "Entry Period"). Entries submitted before or after the Entry Period will not be eligible. Sponsor's computer is the official time-keeping device for the Sweepstakes.
- 3. **How to Enter:** You will receive an e-mail or link from Sponsor requesting that you complete an online survey related to child care programs' experience. Follow the link to complete the survey during the Entry Period, and, upon submission of your information collected such as name and email address and completion of the survey, you will be entered into the Sweepstakes. There is a limit of one (1) entry per person and you may not use multiple e-mail addresses to enter. The use of an agency or any automated system to enter is strictly prohibited, and Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any entries received through such methods, as determined by Sponsor, in its sole discretion. If you choose not to fill out the survey, you can still enter the sweepstakes by emailing advocacy@naeyc.org with your name, email, and the name of your early childhood education program.
- 4. **Drawing:** On or about February 5, Sponsor will select 20 potential winners in a random drawing of all entries received. The odds of being selected depend on the number of entries received. Sponsor will attempt to notify potential winners within 10 business days of the drawing.
- 5. Requirements of Potential Winner(s): Except where prohibited, a potential winner may be required to complete and return an affidavit of eligibility and liability/publicity release. If a potential winner fails to sign and return these documents within the required time period, an alternate potential winner may be selected in his/her place in a random drawing of all remaining entries received. Only three (3) alternate potential winners may be contacted.
- 6. **Prize(s):** The prize will be either a \$100 Visa gift card or a complimentary admission to NAEYC's Public Policy Forum (\$100 value for NAEYC members; \$130 for non-NAEYC-members) that will be sent virtually to the recipient using the email address provided. There will be 10 gift cards available and 10 complimentary admissions to the NAEYC virtual Public Policy Forum on February 25th and 26th, 2024. The first 10 names drawn will be offered a Visa gift card, the next 10 names drawn will be offered a complimentary registration to NAEYC's virtual Public Policy Forum. A gift card winner is responsible for paying any applicable income taxes and any and all other costs and expenses not listed above. Any prize details not specified above will be determined by Sponsor, in its sole discretion. A prize may not be transferred and must be accepted as awarded. A winner may not request cash or a substitute prize; however, Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a prize with another prize of equal or greater value if the prize is not available for any reason, as determined by Sponsor, in its sole discretion.
